Dear Blade Fencing:

How much would it cost to construct a moving personal fence around my body? I have 36 inch waist and would need another 30 inches all the way around myself for personal space and to account for my normal walking stride. By this I mean 30 inches in front of me, 30 inches along each side of me and 30 inches behind me. So the fence would have to be dome shaped where all of the sides connect at the top and curve out to the right dimensions to give me that full 30 inch space. Maybe you could design it as something I could wear on my head, with three or four support arms which would rest against me at chest or waist level to stabilize it, but I'd leave those specifics up to you because you are the fence experts.


