Dear Mistral Bistro:

I am looking for a job and I thought perhaps you had an opening.

I suffer from a medical condition that results in excessive urination. I have never actually overflowed a toilet during one of my extreme urinations, but that is only because once the urine fills the toilet bowl past a certain level, the toilet flushes itself.
