Dear Movie Magic Makers:

I have the site location already lined up, I just need someone to build it. Please let me know if this is something you can handle. If not, I need to find someone else quickly or convince Jimbo's lady to put off the wedding for another year. How much would this cost? Once this prank is over, Bob's friend in Yavapai County, Arizona plans to secretly market "opposite-town" Sandusky to other pranksters in my town and charge a hefty fee to play similar pranks on other people, so he is going to help finance the construction. I'm sure he will have phase plans to slowly replace the empty façade buildings with full interiors so that future guests can pick and choose which buildings they need to be "real."
